

In many cases crew members finish their duty on the next calendar day. In the '**FTL Sheet**' report, if such a duty is done, the **duty-end date** is displayed right next to the exact duty-end time and the next day duty-time is **blank**.

- **Example 1** - single leg trip.

The duty starts on **13-02** at 21:00 UTC, ends on **14-02** at 10:25 UTC.

| Date | Duty Type | Duty Start | Duty End |
|------------|-----------|------------|----------------|
| 13-02-2014 | LTN-BKK | 21:00 | 10:25 (14 Feb) |
| 14-02-2014 | G-LEON | | |

- **Example 2** - 2-legs trip.

The duty of the **1st leg** starts on **01-03** at 22:00 UTC, ends on **02-03** at 02:00 UTC.

The duty of the **2nd leg** starts on **02-03** at 21:00 UTC, ends on **03-02** at 00:45 UTC.

| Date | Duty Type | Duty Start | Duty End |
|------------|-----------|------------|---------------|
| 01-03-2014 | WAW-VKO | 22:00 | 02:00 (2 Mar) |
| 02-03-2014 | VKO-WAW | 21:00 | 00:45 (3 Mar) |
| 03-03-2014 | | | |
