

If the number of passengers added in Legs Info > Pax exceeds the aircraft capacity, which can be input in OPS > Fleet Edit, Leon will display a warning: **“Number of passengers has exceeded the capacity of the aircraft”** (see example below).

The capacity of the aircraft is added in **Fleet Edit** screen.
