

Aircraft on ground or **AOG** is a term in aviation maintenance indicating that a problem is serious enough to prevent an aircraft from flying.

There is a possibility to mark a checkbox **AOG** (Aircraft On Ground) in the section Maintenance > Scheduled Maintenance > Edit Scheduled Maintenance



The appearance slightly changes in the Planned Flights section - 'MAINTENANCE' is being replaced by **AOG**.
